JOE AND SHIRLEY AMENDT Watertown, SD

“IT’S HUGEY REWARDING TO HAVE DONE THIS”

It’s fun to visit with Joe and Shirley Amendt. In short order one learns they love their local community, but have traveled widely. They see not only the needs around them but they desire to do what they can to help. They both like telling stories, but especially Joe. Their love for each other is obvious, as is their love for their faith and the wide-ranging ministries they are supporting.

With the help of the Catholic Community Foundation, the Amendts recently completed the sale of a triplex, and with the proceeds they are providing needed funds to support ministries which are important to them.

“Catholic education is the future, it’s a priority,” they said in talking about supporting Catholic education at their local school, Immaculate Conception, Watertown. But they feel similarly about supporting their parish, Holy Name of Jesus, Watertown, through a gift to the Holy Name Foundation, and in supporting priest retirement and seminarian education with gifts to those endowments.

Through the Foundation they became familiar with and toured the Bishop Dudley Hospitality House, the shelter serving emergency needs and seeking to help people in long term need. That tour moved them to include the Dudley House on their list of gift recipients.

Their pastor, Fr. Michael Wensing, also helped them determine what ministries to support with the sale.

“We told him what we thought was important and we talked it through with him.” Shirley had become aware of Project Rachel and Rachel’s Vineyard, which are ministries offered to help those suffering after an abortion. Catholic Family Services facilitates those ministries in the Diocese of Sioux Falls, and the Amendts included a gift for it as well.

“It’s hugely rewarding to have done this,” the Amendts said. They feel blessed in their lives, more so these days as both have lived through bouts with cancer.

The Foundation’s help was essential. The Amendts have long known Marne Hult, the Gift Planning Officer in the Watertown community office and were comfortable working with her as she helped them consider gifts to multiple ministries. Andrew Bartell, Director of Gift Planning assisted with the sale of the triplex.

Their generosity is not limited to the sale of the triplex – among other things they have provided support to the Perpetual Adoration Sisters of the Blessed Sacrament and provide tuition assistance to students at IC school.

The Amendts encourage others to consider how they can make the most of their donations. “Talk to the Catholic Community Foundation people – they know the options. Find a priest you trust to talk it through,” they said.

"AN ARMS RACE OF SERVICE"

In the Dean's office in the University of South Dakota School of Law, Neil Fulton is reviewing the most recent set of proposals on his desk. He has recently become the 14th Dean of the school and has big plans. Fulton visions one of the top small law schools in the Midwest with a culture of excellence, service, and leadership.

This sort of challenge is nothing new to Neil, or the Fulton family, for that matter. Over the past several years, taking on a daunting task, but doing it because it is part of their stewardship and the right thing to do, seems to be what Neil and wife, Molly, have been called to do.

When they lived in Pierre, they were a part of a community effort to ensure that St. Joseph School would continue its excellence in education for generations to come.

"The opportunity to grow existing endowments for the school, and launching the Pierre Catholic Foundation, was going to be a challenge, but when our community began to realize how many ministries we could impact, you rise to the challenge," said Molly.

"I remember hearing, 'if we do not do this, then who will?' but the community knew the importance, the significance of it all - that is what drove us and those around us - it always came back to seeing something difficult, but being open to saying 'yes' to the calling which was in front of us."

In 2016, Neil was working as the federal public defender for North and South Dakota, and Molly as an artist, joined the Catholic Community Foundation Board of Directors.

"One of the things we found after attending board meetings is we always come away with a renewed energy, from talking with other board members, to hearing about what other community offices are doing, we feel a deeper sense to help grow and support the ministries of the entire Diocese," said Neil, as Molly nods her head in agreement.

"It also allows us the opportunity to think about ways in which we can use the talents we know of, as well as discover talents we may not have known we have had all along," said Molly.

"As Catholics, we are called to strive in all ways to leave the communities around us, to those who follow after, greater than it is was left to us. When you give of your time, talent, or treasure, you are doing just that," said Molly. "It doesn't necessarily need to be all three - it can be just one of these things, you are still being a good steward," added Neil.

"I love the analogy 'It's easy to plant flowers when you should plant trees,' meaning you see the benefits right away from planting flowers, but it takes twenty years before you see the benefits of planting the trees," said Neil. "I may not directly see the benefits of me contributing my treasure to cemeteries, or to seminarian education, but I will use that cemetery - hopefully a long time from now - but eventually, I will come to use it. And I may not have a son called to the priesthood, and benefit from Seminarian Education Endowment, but I may have a grandson who does."

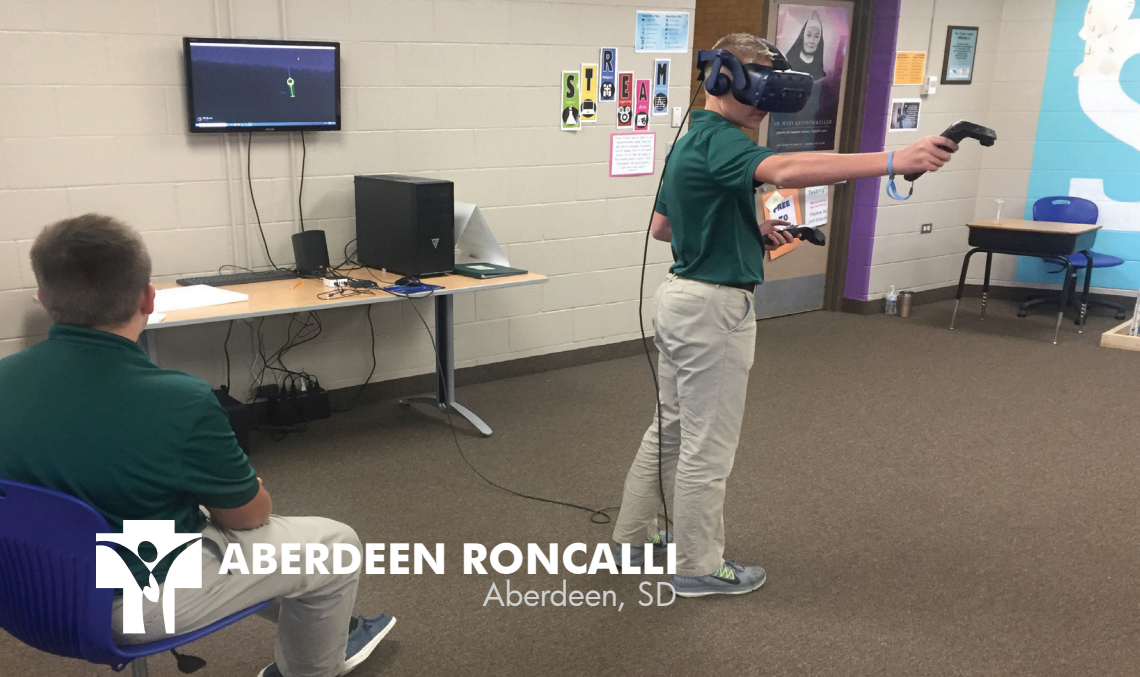

CATHOLIC COMMUNITY FOUNDATION GRANTS HELP MEET NEEDS ACROSS THE DIOCESE: Aberdeen Roncalli STREAMLab making difference to students

Schools across the country understandably have been focusing on what are known as STEM classes – science, technology, engineering and math – as a way to prepare students for the ever-changing world.

Catholic schools are doing the same with a twist that provides an advantage – STREAM classes – science, technology, religion, engineering, arts and math.

A grant from the Catholic Community Foundation for Eastern South Dakota helped Roncalli Catholic schools in Aberdeen complete a STREAMLab for the junior and senior high school students last year.

The advantage of the STREAM vs the STEM is that it “provides opportunities for all students of varying interests and abilities to explore diversified areas of these subjects with overtones of God’s organization and love woven through the curriculum,” according to the application for the grant.

Jennifer Gosicki is the facilitator of the Junior High/High School STREAMLab.

“I, personally and professionally, could not teach without including religion in my curriculum. It is who we are at Roncalli. Praying together with my students and growing our faith is a journey that I passionately embrace. The arts is a natural partner with many STEM activities. The students are led to appreciate all of the components of our STREAM initiative.”

Gosicki said the mission of the STREAMLab is to prepare students through a rigorous, relevant, and interdisciplinary learning environment to be successful and productive citizens.

“By fostering a joy of discovery while developing a strong work ethic, we promote a collaborative culture and high-level, critical thinking skills that are needed to solve problems in the real world. At Roncalli, we are trying to step beyond the typical teacher-lead instruction to offer real world, hands-on exploration, learning and application. We desire to continue to improve our students’ experiences and build various curriculum to meet their needs and interests.

The impact is across the entire Roncalli system.

“The entire staff PreK - 12th grade (currently) is STEM Certified through Northern State University and all students are serviced by a STREAMLab facilitator,” she said.

The grant process offered by the Catholic Community Foundation has helped scores of schools, parishes and other ministries either start or complete a project. The funds for the grants come from endowments where donors have left the use of the interest unrestricted, allowing current needs across the diocese to be met in a timely way.

Gosicki notes that the nature of tools involved in the Lab is that they will need regular updating to be effective.

“Our goal of providing a faith-based Catholic education with high academic standards while nurturing the mind, body and soul is always before us. Sincerely, we appreciate the Catholic Community Foundation for your past support. It has been an important part of the equation as we work toward providing the tools necessary for a productive, successful and faith-filled life to our students. Being full of ever changing and developing technologies, the STREAMLabs are never ‘completed’ ... we invite any potential investors to visit our Labs to see the learning in person. It is an exciting environment,” she said.

Other funding for the STREAMLab came from private gifts from Roncalli families and local Aberdeen businesses, and other grants.

GRANT OPPORTUNITIES

The Catholic Community Foundation has a modest amount of grant money available for distribution from its unrestricted endowments. The following policies and procedures have been adapted in managing grant distributions.

- Grant requests for financial assistance over \$1,000 require the review and approval of the Board of Directors and/or the Grant Review Committee of the Catholic Community Foundation.
- Grants are only made to ministries that follow Catholic moral and social values.
- Requests shall be limited to those that will better serve the spiritual, educational, health and social needs of the people served by the Catholic Diocese of Sioux Falls where other financial resources are not available.
- Grants are not made to capital campaigns, other endowments or individuals, i.e., individual scholarships, etc., but to ministry programs, projects and institutions.
- Grants are not typically awarded to fund 100% of a project or a program need.

Preference will be given to:

- Programs that are associated with a parish, Catholic school or ministry within the Catholic Church of eastern South Dakota.
- A Diocesan-wide ministry designed to support the Church in fulfilling her call to evangelize to the faithful and non-believers alike.
- Programing that has the greatest impact on the largest number of people.
- A ministry established for the benefit of a particular parish community or a small number and regional collection of parish communities.
- Community outreach ministries that complement ministries of the Catholic Church
- One-time gifts, versus multi-year gifts, to help initiate new programming
- Requests that seek matching funds for greater community engagement.

Applications are reviewed twice a year and must be submitted to the Catholic Foundation before March 1, or September 1.



FROM THE ASHES, A RESTORED PARISH CHURCH

The fire that damaged Our Lady of Guadalupe Church in Sioux Falls in December of 2018 felt like a death to some of the parishioners.

"Many parishioners didn't even want to go inside, unable to bear the heartache of seeing their church in such a state," said Fr. Kristopher Cowles, pastor.

"For many of the people, the fire in itself was significant but the fact that the first major artifact that burned in the Church was the Image of Our Lady of Guadalupe was heartbreaking to the people.

"Often times, after asking about whether anyone was hurt, this was the first question that was asked, 'How is Our Lady?' not 'How is the image?' This is how much they identify with the image and their mother.

"However, once they found out that the positioning of the image in the church was just so, so that it drew all the smoke, air, and fire toward it, they realized that she in a sense protected the church and others from further damage," he said.

Catholics are Easter people who know that after death comes resurrection.

"For many of our parishioners, it is as if the words of Easter Sunday became their own, 'He is Risen, he is truly Risen.' They witnessed in their faith and their church building a rebirth, a renewal, a resurrection. And just as the body of Jesus was changed and transfigured, so also has our building and faith been changed, deepened, and strengthened," said Fr. Cowles.

The Catholic Community Foundation for Eastern South Dakota helped. While insurance, parishioners and even a GoFundMe effort all contributed, there just wasn't enough to refurbish and refinish everything.

That's where the Catholic Community Foundation came in and made a real difference.

"They are a Godsend to our diocese and especially to my parish. The Catholic Community Foundation acted as a bridge between the pastor/parish and the donors," said Fr. Cowles.

"I am not particularly gifted in asking for gifts. It actually terrifies me. They were able to do what I was not.

"They consulted with me and sought out generous hearts who desired to give to this Church where many of them had served, worshiped, grown, and received their sacraments," he said.

Catholic Community Foundation Gift Planning Officer, Katie Fritz, said inquiring about needs around the diocese is something she and her co-workers do regularly.

"Visiting with donors and listening to what they care about is what I do," she said. "To be able to connect people with their passions and experience the joy of giving is remarkable and humbling," she said.

Fr. Cowles said the help from the Catholic Community Foundation goes beyond the critically important donations.

"They were able to refine and clarify the scope of the project by asking pointed



questions. Because of their contact base, they were able to reach out with confidence to those who had invested with the foundation. They also gave a friendly face to Our Lady of Guadalupe while my bearded burly profile at times, may intimidate," he said.

Fr. Cowles encourages use of the resources of the Foundation by both those in need and those with means.

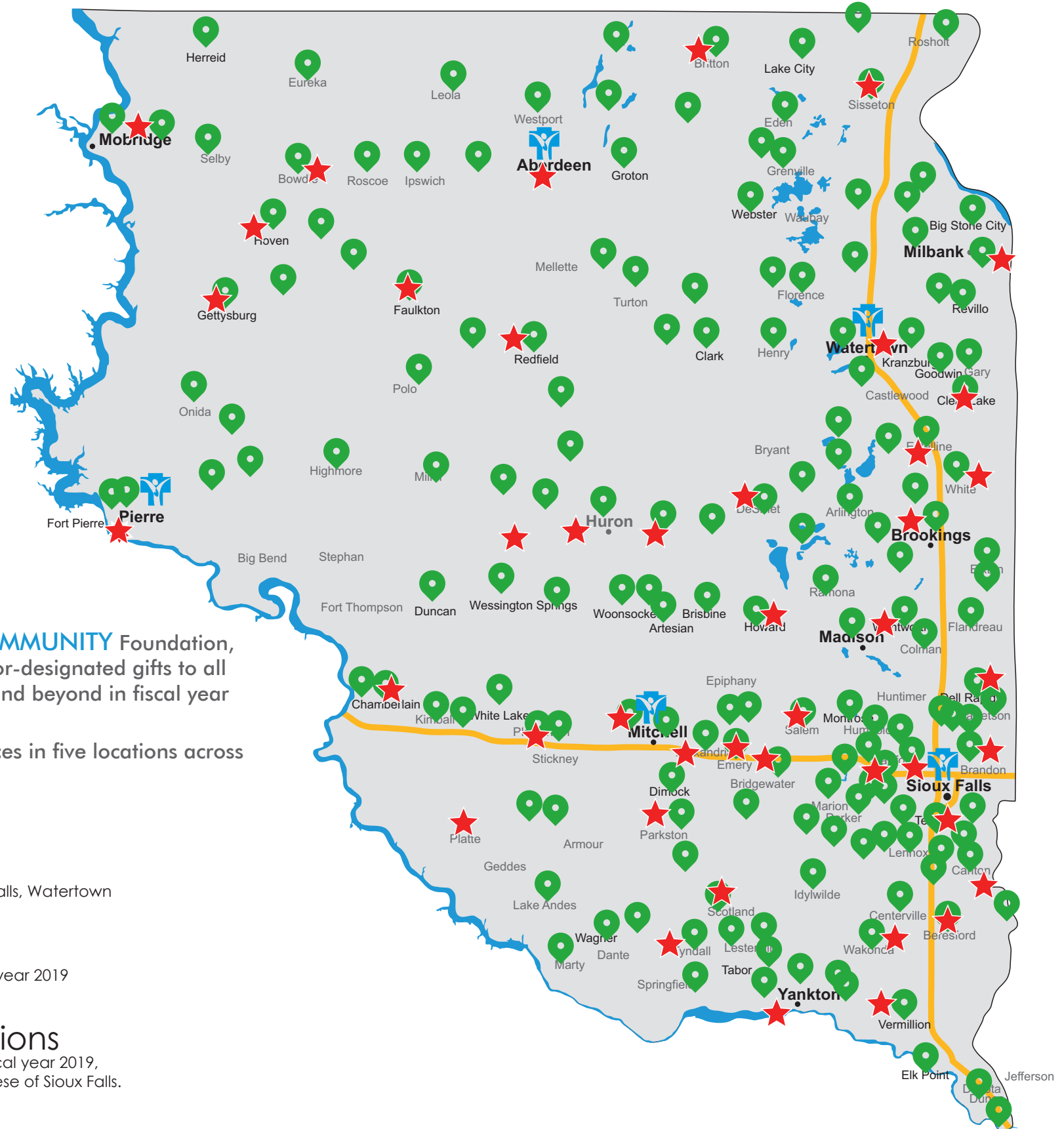
Donor Locations

END OF LIFE PLANNING FOR CATHOLICS

WORKBOOK, SEMINARS HELP COMMUNITY FOUNDATION OFFICES MEET END OF LIFE NEEDS

Thanks to a partnership between the Diocese of Sioux Falls Office of Marriage, Family and Respect Life and the Catholic Community Foundation for Eastern South Dakota, Nicole Fuhrer from the Mitchell Community office now has the tools she needs to meet a specific unmet need – end of life planning.

“One prevalent theme we hear from parishioners across the diocese, is that preparing for the end of our lives can be scary and overwhelming,” Fuhrer said.

“Often times it goes undone; and surviving family members are faced with making important decisions at a time when they are grieving and unprepared. That can cause great heartache and sometimes uncomfortable family situations,” she said.

To meet the need, the offices worked together to create a comprehensive workbook, along with a series of seminars around the diocese to help people feel better about being prepared for the end of life.

“The workbook grounds us in the truth that everything we are (our very being) and everything we have, is a gift from God. It is a step by step process to help prepare for all aspects of the end of life with our Catholic values in mind,” Fuhrer said.

Emily Leedom, Director of the Office of Marriage Family and Respect Life added, “We see in the Gospel that Christ's care for the sick and dying is clear. Because He has opened the gates of Heaven to us, we can prepare in immense hope and with great peace - remembering always that we are pilgrims on a journey home. Being intentional with an end of life plan offers peace and freedom for ourselves and our loved ones as we enter into the final stages of life.

Using these tools, gift planning officers in community offices around the diocese (in addition to Mitchell, also in Pierre, Aberdeen, Watertown and Sioux Falls) can meet with people in parish or home settings to help them.

“It is a great gift to walk alongside (people) in this process. It is a comprehensive tool that includes end of life medical care, funeral, burial and estate planning. It can prepare them to meet with a priest, funeral planner, financial planner or attorney. One thing we strongly encourage is to be open about these plans with your family, as a way to pass on your values and legacy of faith,” she said.

The end of life workbook, and the meetings to explain it, helps encourage conversation about the critical matters of life, especially faith and the handing on of that faith. It's a role the community officers welcome having in all the communities across eastern South Dakota.

PREPARATION, PLANNING, PRIESTHOOD

These days it is not that unusual for people to have a second career in a field very different from their original line of work. For Dr. Ed Anderson, after 30 years as an anesthesiologist, that second career lead him to the priesthood. It was also what introduced him to the Catholic Community Foundation for Eastern South Dakota.

"My original major donation was when I entered the seminary, and it was an expression of my appreciation of being accepted as a seminarian," said Fr. Ed. "My most recent donation was an attempt to appreciate the results of the donation and also to be able to direct it to where it was most needed."

After completing theological preparation, Fr. Ed was ordained a priest for the Diocese of Sioux Falls in 2008 at age 65. He serves as chaplain at Avera Prince of Peace in Sioux Falls.

"I am a priest during what would be normally considered as my pre-priest retirement years, and I have experienced great joy in being a priest. I am presently 76 and hope to continue here at Prince of Peace as long as I am able," he said.

His more recent work with the Catholic Community Foundation allowed him to complete his end of life planning, including his will; to direct gifts to ministries he wants to support, and feel the peace of having help to get it all done.

"Everyone at the Catholic Community Foundation was extremely knowledgeable, helpful, pleasant, and easy to work with. There was never any pressure on me, and there was always a great relationship between us," Fr. Ed said.

"As I get older, I experience what many people experience and that is not necessarily having a close relative nearby and desiring someone to help with possible end of life decisions. The Chancellor is my Durable Power of Attorney for Health Care and Life Issues. I hope that when I am not capable of making decisions that he will be able to help with them," he said.

Fr. Ed said his decision to make particular gifts now, as well as plan for end of life gifts makes sense and brings him joy and peace.

"The benefit of donating now is that one can direct where it is needed and also see the results of the donation. To be able to see the results of the planning and donation are, I believe, the true value of donating now.

"I very highly recommend using the Catholic Community Foundation for planning," Fr. Ed said. "They make excellent recommendations regarding how to direct one's donation and are experts at setting things up. Also, they help alleviate any questions and/or confusion one might have regarding the donation process."

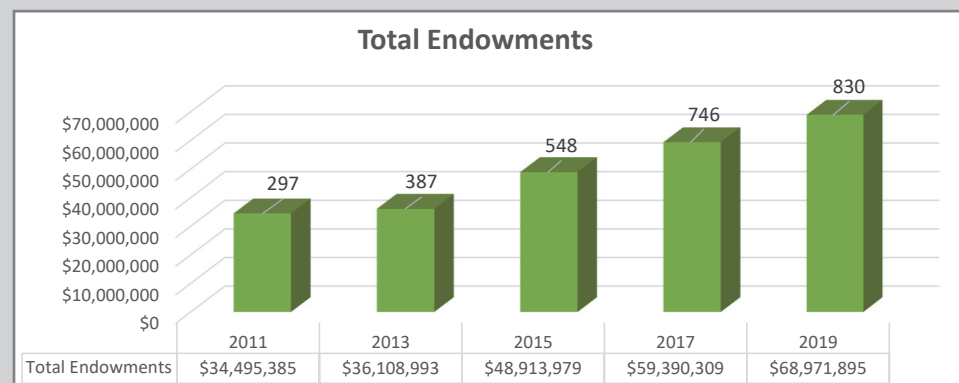
All of which frees him up to focus on his work at Prince of Peace.

"As I said, I hope to continue working as a priest as long as I am able since I so enjoy the priesthood and ministering to the people so much."

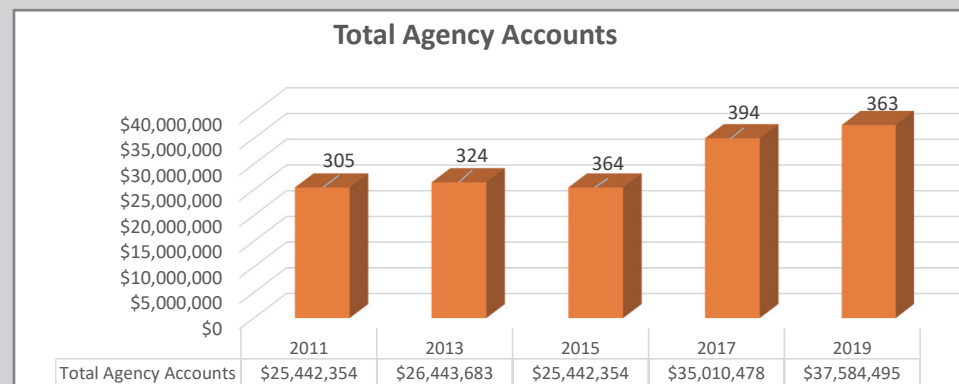

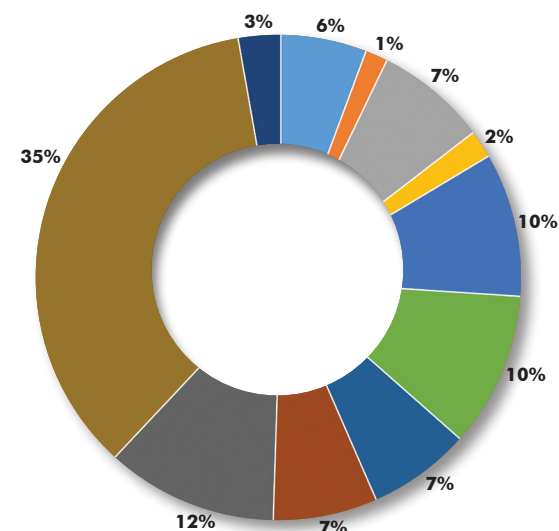

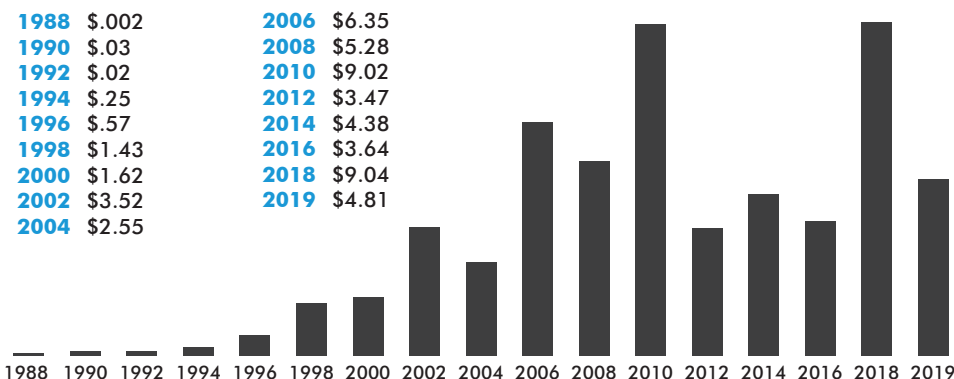


FUNDS UNDER MANAGEMENT (MILLIONS)

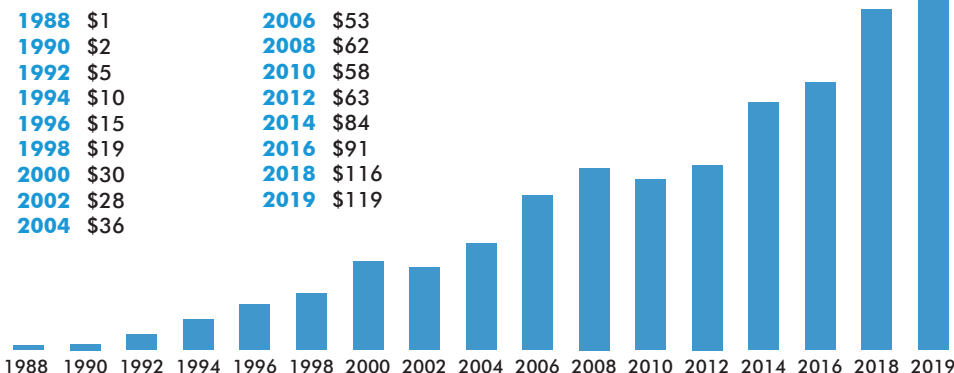
